- 1. **Golden Gate Bridge** Iconic views of the Bay and city skyline; walk or bike across for unforgettable photos.
- 2. **Alcatraz Island** Explore the infamous former prison with an engaging audio tour full of history.
- 3. **California Academy of Sciences** A one-stop wonder in Golden Gate Park: aquarium, planetarium, rainforest, and natural history museum.
- 4. **Fisherman's Wharf & Pier 39** Lively waterfront with sea lions, street performers, and fresh seafood.
- 5. **San Francisco Museum of Modern Art (SFMOMA)** World-class modern and contemporary art in a striking architectural setting.

- 6. **De Young Museum** Fine arts museum in Golden Gate Park featuring American art and a stunning observation tower.
- 7. **Painted Ladies at Alamo Square** Snap the famous Victorian houses framed by the city skyline.
- 8. **Chinatown** The oldest Chinatown in North America, filled with vibrant shops, restaurants, and cultural sites.
- 9. **Mission District Murals** Colorful street art paired with amazing local cuisine, including the famous Mission-style burritos.
- 10. **Ferry Building Marketplace** A foodie haven with artisanal shops, fresh produce, and waterfront views.
